ABOUT VOICE OF HOPE

Voice of Hope Ministries (VOH) is an organization serving inner-city families of West Dallas, the 11th poorest community in the nation—where 49% of the residents live in poverty, and 75% of the adults lack a high school education. In meeting the needs of the whole child, Voice of Hope offers programs for youths 4 to 18 years old, including the Aspire After School program, Summer Day Camp, Mission Impact, and other family assistance and community outreach programs, including summer employment for teens.

Snapshot of Voice of Hope Summer Day Camp

- In 2009, 350 children attended day camps and extended day camps.
- In our 17 prior years, Grand Prix has raised over \$100,000, and has enhanced the lives of thousands of deserving kids.

The idea for the race was conceived by Preston Center Club members Bob Ikel (aka Ikelbahn) and Fred Seipp (aka FastFred) in 1992. Ikelbahn was a friend of a Dallas kart track operator, and spawned the idea. FastFred had been a driver in Porsche Club Racing, and was the director of the Grand Prix of Dallas professional car race.

Grand Prix-style go-kart racing is on an outdoor slick track. It's fun and exciting, at speeds of 30mph.

Le Mans Enduro Racing

Your team has five drivers who race three full teams on the track at the same time. This is not a relay. Computer counting is used for accurate time records. Each kart is individually timed, and the five times are combined. Driving skills and teamwork win! This will take leadership, communication, coordination, and time management skills to finish first. Can you do it?
